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# DAY 1: ARRIVAL DAY: CAPE TOWN

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## **Arrival Cape Town International Airport**

**On arrival at Cape Town International Airport you will be welcomed by a Winners Staff member, who will assist you to your transfer.**

**Once luggage has been loaded, you will be transferred to The Portswood Hotel where accommodation has been reserved for 3 nights on Bed and Breakfast basis**

## **[THE PORTSWOOD HOTEL:](#)**



Located on the V&A Waterfront, this chic hotel offers free Wi-Fi and an outdoor swimming pool with terrace. Guests can benefit from 24-hour room service. Guest rooms of The Portswood are decorated in a maritime style and offer air conditioning and satellite TV. Each room has an en-suite bathroom with a bathtub and shower. A rich breakfast is served daily. The poolside terrace offers a charming setting for a light snack or drink. Guests can also visit the Quarterdeck Restaurant with its Indian cuisine and Cape Malay decorations. The cocktail bar is available for drinks. The Portswood Hotel is situated 3 km from the city centre and 25 km from Cape Town International Airport.

# DAY 2: CAPE TOWN

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## Breakfast to be enjoyed at Hotel

09h00:

**Depart from the hotel and travel with your English Speaking Guide from the hotel via Sea Point, Camps Bay onto Hout Bay .**

**Enjoy a stop at Hout Bay Harbour with the option of a boat trip to Seal Island. Proceed to Cape Point Nature Reserve via Champmans Peak Drive.**

[The 9km Chapman' s Peak Drive](#) winds its way between Noordhoek and Hout Bay on the Atlantic Coast on the south-western tip of South Africa. Chapman's Peak Drive is one of the most spectacular marine drives in the world.

Affectionately known as "Chappies" and is a must for anyone who is passionate about the majestic Cape Town scenery, with sheer drops to the sea below and towering mountains rising above you. The twists and curves in the road seem endless and it is a photographers dream. It is a paradise for motorists, sightseers, picnickers, runners, hikers and bikers (both the motorised and the manual varieties).



## [Cape Point Nature Reserve](#)

At Cape Point the warm Mozambique current meets the cold Benguela current, making a significant impact on all forms of marine life in the vicinity and on the flora of the peninsula.

The reserve was started in 1936 to preserve the indigenous flora and fauna of the Cape Peninsula. Though exposed, often windswept, and less verdant than the rest of the Peninsula, the 7750ha reserve has as many plant varieties as there are in the whole of Britain. In addition to the predominating Protea and heath varieties there are numerous endangered species and a few that are found nowhere else. The fauna includes eland, bontebok, rhebok, grysbok, springbok, baboon, porcupine, ostrich and zebra.



The principal road through the reserve ends near the summit of Cape Point from where you have the choice to walk or to take a funicular up the steep slope to the highest point. From this position the panorama is breathtaking, encompassing



the whole of False Bay and the Hottentots Holland Mountains beyond.

By far the most dramatic view, however, is downward, for the vantage point is 209m above the rocks at which point the warm Mozambique current meets the cold Benguela current.

**From here guests will travel towards Simonstown, stopping at a very special scenic spot; the Seaforth.**

**13h30 Lunch at the Seaforth Restaurant**

**Seaforth Restaurant**

Set on the white sands of Seaforth Beach in Simon's Town, with stunning views of mountains and sea, and penguins to entertain you, Seaforth Restaurant is a spectacular venue on the water's edge.

Seaforth offers you the opportunity to delight in the fruits of the sea, or a range of platters fit for the most discerning palate.



**15h00: Depart from Seaforth and travel to Boulders Beach to view the penguin colony.**



**16h30: After a visit to the Penguins, travel back to hotel where tour will disembark between 17h30 and 18h00.**

## DAY 3: CAPE TOWN

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**Enjoy breakfast at Hotel**

**09h00: Depart on a half day City sightseeing tour, followed by an excursion to Table Mountain.**



**Table Mountain** is one of the official New 7 Wonders of Nature, following a lengthy international public voting process. You can get to the top of Cape Town's most famous icon in just five minutes by taking a cable car up, or spend the better part of your day hiking it. Table Mountain Cableway, established in 1929, takes visitors to the top in one of two cable cars, each with rotating

floors and huge windows to ensure your views while travelling are almost as spectacular as those on the summit. Cable cars depart every 10 to 15 minutes. From the top of Table Mountain, there are magnificent views of the Cape Town city centre, surrounding suburbs and the Atlantic Ocean. Landmarks in view include Cape Town Stadium, Robben Island and Camps Bay beach.

**On return from the mountain proceed via the Bo-Kaap back to your hotel where tour terminates on arrival**

**Afternoon at leisure to discover the sights and sounds of the Mother City**

## DAY4: CAPE TOWN - HERMANUS

Proceed through the small town of Fisherheaven, Hawton & Sandbaai to Hermanus, where accommodation has been reserved at Windsor Hotel for 2 nights on Bed and Breakfast basis.**



[The Windsor Hotel](#) is situated on a cliff edge with spectacular panoramic views of the Atlantic/Indian Ocean mix below, visible from almost all its rooms. This Hermanus hotel is perfect for a relaxing seaside holiday break, and the frolicking whales in the Atlantic/Indian Ocean mix will add to your enjoyment! Windsor Hotel has a three star rating and was built in 1896 - making it the oldest accommodation in Hermanus! Of all the Hermanus hotels to be built

since then, the Windsor has remained a popular holiday option. Hermanus offers some of the best land-based whale watching in the world. This is because its waters are the breeding ground and nursery of the famous Southern Right whale. September's whale breeding season sets the scene for the vibey and popular Hermanus whale festival. With its mild Mediterranean climate and safe, clean, sandy Blueflag Beaches, Hermanus is popular all year round. And if you're looking for Hermanus accommodation, look no further than the Windsor Hotel.

**Day at Lesiure to explore the surroundings of Hermanus**



Hermanus (originally called Hermanuspietersfontein, but shortened as the name was too long for the postal service), is a town on the southern coast of the Western Cape province of South Africa. It is famous for Southern Right whale watching during the southern winter and spring and is a popular retirement town. The whales can be seen from the cliffs in the town centre as early as June and usually depart in early December. They were once hunted in the nearby town of Betty's Bay, but are now protected to ensure the survival of the species. The Old Harbour Museum contains several exhibitions that explain the whaling industry, and the De Wetshuis Photo Museum houses an exhibition of photos by T D Ravenscroft that depicts the history of Hermanus. The Whale Museum houses a skeleton of a whale and shows an audio-visual presentation of whales and dolphins twice daily
